The Office of Inspector General is initiating an audit to determine whether the Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) oversight of airport land acquisition and relocation assistance programs ensures that sponsors: (1) acquire property and relocate occupants in accordance with applicable laws and regulations, and (2) are reimbursed only for costs eligible under the Airport Improvement Program.

The audit will be conducted at FAA's Office of Airport Planning and Programming in Washington, D.C.; and selected FAA field offices and airport sponsors.
