The Office of Inspector General (OIG) is initiating an audit of all Department of Transportation (DOT) web systems connected to the DOT homepage, including specific web sites within the Operating Administrations. The audit will be conducted with automated scanning tools.

The objective of this audit is to determine whether DOT has adequate web security and privacy protection. We also will examine the contents of selected web sites to ensure no information sensitive to homeland security or privacy protection is included. Specifically, we will determine whether DOT's public web sites are (1) adequately secured to reduce the risk of being attacked and are equipped to detect and report abnormal activities or incidents, (2) properly configured to protect the public's privacy when visiting DOT sites, and (3) free of sensitive information.
