The Office of Inspector General has scheduled an audit of the Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) National Airspace System Implementation Support Contract (NISC). The objectives of the audit are to determine whether (1) FAA has adequate contract oversight to identify cost overruns and improper billings, (2) FAA has implemented sound business practices over issuing and administering task orders of the contract, (3) contract deliverables are effectively meeting FAA's requirements and are cost-effective, and (4) contract personnel meet skill and qualification standards outlined in the contract. Planned locations include FAA Headquarters, FAA regional offices, and contractor facilities as determined necessary during our review.

We plan to begin the audit during the week of December 3, 2001. We will contact the audit liaison to arrange a formal entrance conference. Mr. Robert Prinzbach is the Project Manager for this audit.
