Dear Mr. Bacon:

On January 29, 2015, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, Office of Pipeline Safety, issued to Enterprise Products Operating LLC (Enterprise) a Corrective Action Order following the rupture and fire that occurred on its ATEX-1 pipeline near Follansbee, West Virginia. An amended Order was later issued on March 12, 2015. This Order included requirements to take corrective actions on the ATEX-1 pipeline from the Mark West Processing Facility in Houston, Pennsylvania to Seymour, Indiana.

Based on our review of the documentation you provided in the CAO Documentation Report dated January 25, 2016, it has been determined that you have complied with the terms of this Order. We are returning the USB drive containing supporting documents that were submitted with the CAO Documentation Report, as our review has been completed and the USB drive is no longer needed.

Accordingly, this case is now closed, and no further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
