Between March 2014 and December 2014, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Phillips 66's Glacier Crude Pipeline System in Montana. As a result of the inspection, Phillips 66 Pipeline LLC was issued a Notice of Amendment on June 16, 2015, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
