During December 4-6, 2012 a representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Kinder Morgan Liquid Terminals' (KMLT) procedures and records as part of a standard unit inspection in Argo, Illinois.. As a result of the inspection, KMLT was issued a Notice of Amendment on January 25, 2013, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

KMLT submitted its amended procedures to the Asset Integrity Plan on January 30, 2013 in its initial response. KMLT provided two additional responses with updates on February 13th and July 11th. My staff reviewed the amended procedures and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
