Re: Notice of Probable Violation and Proposed Civil Penalty CPF 4-2013-1011

I am writing on behalf of Gulf South Pipeline Company, LP (hereinafter "Gulf South") in response to your Notice of Probable Violation ("NOPV") and Proposed Civil Penalty dated May 20, 2013, which Gulf South received on May 21, 2013, regarding an inspection of its Integrity Management Program. The inspection was conducted October 15-27, 2012 in our Owensboro, Kentucky office.

Regarding Item 1, Gulf South agrees to pay the above-referenced Proposed Civil Penalty and will not contest the NOPV. Accordingly, Gulf South wired payment on June 7, 2013, in the amount of \$16,200.00.

As stated in your NOPV, Gulf South has revised language in its Integrity Management program to address this issue and has communicated this change to appropriate Gulf South employees.
