On October 22 through 26, 2012, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Wyoming Pipeline Company's (WPC) Operations and Maintenance (O&M) procedures in Newcastle, Wyoming. As a result of the inspection, WPC was issued a Notice of Amendment on June 26, 2013, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
