On September 24, 2012 through December 21, 2012, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected American Midstream LLC's Operations and Maintenance Plan procedures in Fairbanks, LA. As a result of the inspection, American Midstream was issued a Notice of Amendment on August 9, 2013, which proposed amendments to your procedures.
