During the week of October 15, 2012, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company's (Transco) procedures in Carlstadt, NJ. As a result of the inspection, Transco was issued a Notice of Amendment on August 20, 2013, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
