Dear Mr. Hulburt:

On October 9, 2012, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), issued to Enterprise Products Operating, LLC (Enterprise) a Final Order in the above-referenced case. This Order included a Compliance Order and Civil Penalty assessment.

We received confirmation of payment of the civil penalty on November 6, 2012. Subsequently, we received a letter dated November 28, 2012, from Kevin Bodenhamer, Senior Vice President, EHS&T at Enterprise, wherein he summarized the actions taken to comply with this Order, along with documents that were enclosed with it. Based on our review of those documents that he provided, injunction with payment of the civil penalty, it has been determined that Enterprise has complied with the terms of this Order.

Accordingly, this case is now closed and no further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case.
