Dear Mr. Pearson:

On various dates in 2010 and 2011, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected the Magellan procedures. As a result of these inspections a Notice of Amendment (NOA) was issued on March 23, 2012 to Magellan.

On August 8, 2013 PHMSA issued an Order Directing Amendment (ODA) requiring Magellan to make certain additional revisions to its procedures. On September 24, 2014, Magellan submitted a response to the ODA that included additional procedural revisions.

Based upon review of the September 24, 2014 Magellan response, PHMSA has determined that the ODA required procedural revisions made by Magellan are acceptable.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed.
