On May 16 to 20, 2011, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Interstate Storage and Pipeline Corporation (ISPC) procedures for its facility in Bordentown, New Jersey. As a result of the inspection, ISPC was issued a Notice of Amendment on April 4, 2012, which proposed amendment of its procedures.
