On May 16 to 20, 2011, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an onsite pipeline safety inspection of Interstate Storage and Pipeline Corporation (ISPC) procedures for its facility in Bordentown, New Jersey. As a result of the inspection, ISPC was issued a Notice of Amendment on April 4, 2012, which proposed amendment of its procedures.
