On May 8, 2012, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued to Mojave Pipeline Operating Company a Safety Order in the above-referenced case. It required Mojave Pipeline Operating Company to take certain corrective measures with respect to the failure of four relieve valves causing a natural gas release at the Bifurcation Point on Mojave Pipeline near Arvin, California. Based on our review of the documentation you provided, it has been determined that you have complied with the terms of this Order.
