On July 6-7, 2011, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected the West Texas Gas, Inc. (WTG) Public Awareness Program at the WTG offices in Plainview, Texas.

A Notice of Probable Violation and Proposed Compliance Order was issued to WTG on May 16, 2012. WTG responded by letter dated June 14, 2012. A Final Order for this case was issued on May 17, 2013.

WTG submitted a copy of amended procedures on June 27, 2013. My staff reviewed the information provided, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Probable Violation and Proposed Compliance Order have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you that no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
