During the week of December 6, 2010, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Transcontinental Gas Pipe line Company's, (Transco) procedures at the Carlstadt LNG Plant. As a result of the inspection, Transco was issued a Notice of Amendment on June 11, 2012, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Transcontinental Gas Pipe line Company submitted its amended procedures on July 11, 2012. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
