During the week of December 5, 2011, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Kiantone Pipeline Corporation's procedures in West Seneca, NY. As a result of the inspection, Kiantone Pipeline Corporation was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 17, 2012, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
