This is in response to your application for renewal of or party status to DOT-SP 9275, which authorizes the transportation in commerce of certain limited quantities of liquids and solids containing ethyl alcohol and exempts these shipments from the provisions of 49 CFR Parts 100-180.

In accordance with 49 CFR 107.113(e) and (g), your application is denied for the following reason(s):

This special permit is no longer necessary. The provisions of DOT-SP 9275 were incorporated into the Hazardous Materials Regulations under Docket No. HM-233C in a final rule published in the Federal Register on March 18, 2014 (79 FR 15033), effective April 17, 2014. The authority is now contained in § 173.150(g).
