On February 2, 2010 a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected OP Reno's operations and maintenance procedures for your Sparks Terminal in Sparks, Nevada. As a result of the inspection, OP Reno, LLC was issued a Notice of Amendment on **CPF 5-2011-6004M**, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

OP Reno responded with their O&M manual dated December 2, 2011. After further discussion and modifications, OP Reno LLC resubmitted their O&M manual on March 1, 2013.

My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
