**Committee Action on Notice of Proposed Rulemaking
& Regulatory Evaluation**

Sample Language to Call a Motion

Committee Action: At the July 11, 2012 meetings of the Technical Pipeline Safety Standards Committee (TPSSC) and the Technical Hazardous Liquid Pipeline Safety Standards Committee (THLPSSC) will consider the notice of proposed rulemaking (NPRM) and the draft regulatory evaluation for the following:

“Pipeline Safety: Miscellaneous Changes to Pipeline Safety Regulations” – (76 FR 73570) published November 29, 2011 – To make miscellaneous changes to the pipeline safety regulations. The proposed changes would correct errors, address inconsistencies, and respond to rulemaking petitions.

Report: The committee’s vote and the meeting transcript constitute the report described in each Committee Charter under “Committee Objectives and Scope of Activities.” Each report is a permanent record of the meeting and filed in the official docket.

Calling a motion: The following is sample language that can be used to call a motion:

1. ___ The proposed rule as published in the *Federal Register* and the Draft Regulatory Evaluation are technically feasible, reasonable, cost-effective, and practicable.
2. ___ The proposed rule as published in the *Federal Register* and the Draft Regulatory Evaluation are technically feasible, reasonable, cost-effective, and practicable if the following changes are made (members insert language of proposed change).
3. ___ The proposed rule as published in the *Federal Register* and the Draft Regulatory Evaluation are not (or cannot be made) technically feasible, reasonable, cost-effective and practicable.
