Dear Mr. McClain:

On December 11, 2012, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) Associate Administrator for Pipeline Safety issued to SFPP, LP a Final Order in the above-referenced case. This Order included a Compliance Order. It required SFPP, LP to take certain measures to evaluate and correct pressure control devices on Line 13 stations and terminals. SFPP, LP has verified completion of necessary changes to in-station thermal pressure relief as proposed in their September 30, 2011 response, "Thermal Protection Table (rev 2)."

Based on our review of the documentation you provided, it has been determined that you have complied with the terms of this Order.
