Dear Mr. Coy:

We received your October 5, 2011 letter issuing a Notice of Proposed Violation and civil penalty for failure to follow procedures for retaining documentation related to three (3) casing locations. Transco paid the \$50,000 fine on October 7, 2011.

In reference to the New York inspection, the auditor identified three (3) casings on Station Island that did not have test leads. As a result, Transco developed a plan of action to address this deficiency. In 2010, the test leads were installed which now allow us to accurately and reliably identify a shorted casing.
