Dear Mr. Munguia:

On July 17, 2013, Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS) issued to Kinder Morgan Liquid Terminals, LLC (KMLT) a Consent Agreement and Order (Agreement) in the above-referenced case. The Order incorporated the terms of the Consent Agreement, which was signed by both PHMSA and KMLT. The Consent Agreement resulted from a Notice of Probable Violation, Proposed Civil Penalty, and Proposed Compliance Order that was issued to KMLT on October 12, 2011.

On October 8, 2015, we received a letter dated October 5, 2015 from KMLT in response to the Consent Agreement, stating that the MOP substantiation project was completed at Carteret on September 23, 2015.

Subsequently, we received a letter dated October 7, 2015 from KMLT which stated that the final work set forth in Section II of the Consent Agreement had been completed, and requested confirmation that the Agreement had been terminated. Based on our review of the documentation KMLT provided and confirmation of payment of the civil penalty, it has been determined that KMLT has complied with the terms of the Agreement.

Accordingly, this case is now closed, and no further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case.
