

DOT Special Permits

Airgas

Special Permits

- In depth training is found in the Airgas
 - HM 126f manual
 - HM 126f ELearning program
 - Hydrotesting manual
 - Driver Training manual (which is also included in the Airgas Transportation manual)

DOT Exemption = DOT Special Permit

- Many years ago (over 20) the DOT used the name Special Permit
- Then it changed to Exemption
- Now it has changed back to Special Permit
- Exemption or Special Permit mean the same

Special Permits

- Special Permits are currently issued by the DOT's Pipeline and Hazardous Material Safety Administration
- Known as PHMSA
- http://hazmat.dot.gov/sp_app/special_permits/spec_perm_index.htm
- Washington, DC office – 1-202-366-4535

Special Permits

- As of May 2008 over 14,400 different exemptions/special permits have been issued
- Each one is unique and you must read the entire, current edition of the special permit to ensure compliance

Special Permits

- SAFECOR sends a DOT Special Permit update to the field every 90 days
- Sent to the Regional VP of Operations and Regional Safety Directors
- Lists the common special permits that Airgas is a Grantee to or operates under
- If your business unit operates under a special permit not listed on the update, please contact John Anderson

Special Permits

- Common issues
 - Unless exempted the DOT-SP and number must be entered onto the hazardous material shipping paper in association with the proper shipping name
 - Example of one exempted is DOT-SP 12391

Special Permit

- Common issues
 - Container will be marked with DOT-E or DOT-SP and the number
 - Bulk containers will normally be marked on both sides
 - Bulk container markings will normally be at least 2 inches in height

Special Permit

- Common issues
 - The special permit is required to be kept at the location that offers the product for transportation
 - Depending on the mode of transportation (highway, rail, air, or water) a copy may also be required to be provided to the carrier

Special Permit

- Common issues
 - Often restricts the products in the container
 - Often requires additional container testing
 - Often requires additional documentation
 - May limit travel time i.e. time the container may be in transportation

Special Permits

- Common issues
 - Initial special permit good for 2 years
 - Renewals will be good for 4 years

Special Permit

- Key points to remember
- Over 14,400 different special permits have been issued.
- All are unique
- If you see DOT-SP or DOT-E and a number, STOP what you are doing and read, understand and comply with the terms of the Special Permit

Two types of Special Permits

- **Manufacture, mark and sale Special Permit**
 - Allows for the manufacture, mark and sale of a non DOT specification container
 - Will be marked as a Special Permit container not a DOT specification container
- **Users Special Permit**
 - Allows the “user” of a DOT specification container to perform a task not authorized by the regulations
 - Will be marked as a DOT Specification container

Manufacture, mark and sale Special Permit

- Must have a current copy on site
- Must follow all requirements of the special permit
- Does not require Grantee or Party to the Exemption status
- Documented training for all employees performing a function regulated by the special permit

Users Special Permit

- Must have a current copy on site
- Must follow all requirements of the special permit
- Requires Grantee or Party to the Exemption status
- Documented training for all employees performing a function regulated by the special permit

Special Permits

- In depth training is found in the Airgas
 - HM 126f manual
 - HM 126f ELearning program
 - Hydrotesting manual
 - Driver Training manual (which is also included in the Airgas Transportation manual)

Special Permits

- Document all training
- Document general knowledge of special permits
- Document specific knowledge unique to individual special permits your business unit operates under

Special Permits

- If you see DOT-SP or DOT-E and a number, STOP what you are doing and read, understand and comply with the terms of the Special Permit
- If you have a question about the special permit, ask your supervisor or Safety Director
- If in doubt – do not fill, requalify or offer the container for transportation
