### <u>CERTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 1201 OF</u> THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT

Pursuant to Title XII, section 1201, of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Pub. L. 111-5 (Feb. 17, 2009)) ("ARRA"), I Brad Henry, the Governor of the State of Oklahoma, hereby certify to the Secretary of Transportation that the State of Oklahoma will maintain its effort with regard to State funding for the types of projects in DOT "covered programs" funded under ARRA. The enclosed list of DOT "covered programs" identifies the amount of funds the State plans to expend from State sources from February 17, 2009, to September 30, 2010, for the types of projects under the DOT "covered programs" funded under ARRA.

I understand that if the State of Oklahoma is unable to maintain the level of funding identified in this list of the types of projects under the DOT "covered programs" funded under ARRA, the State of Oklahoma will thereafter be prohibited by the Secretary of Transportation from receiving additional limitation on obligations for Federal-aid highway and highway safety construction programs that occur after August 1 for fiscal year 2011.
