• Disturbance 1 - located a few hundred miles east-northeast of northern Lesser Antilles; formation chance through 48 hours low near zero percent, five days low 20 percent

### **Eastern Pacific:**

• Disturbance 1 - located a few hundred miles south of coast of El Salvador; formation chance through 48 hours low near zero percent, five days low 20 percent

#### Western Pacific:

- Disturbance 1 (Invest 99W) located 296 miles east-northeast of Andersen Air Force Base (AFB), Guam; formation chance through 24 hours high
- Disturbance 2 (Invest 90W) located 299 miles west-southwest of Andersen AFB, Guam; formation chance through 24 hours medium


- Rain/thunderstorms New England back thru Midwest/Ohio Valley to central/southern Plains
- Isolated severe thunderstorms, large hail and gusty winds portions of northern Oklahoma northeast into northern Missouri
- Isolated strong to severe thunderstorms across western Texas, far southeastern New Mexico
- Rain and snow portions of south-central Rockies
- Rain along Southeast coastal region and Florida peninsula
- Rain from Vancouver Island to northern California; rain/snow Washington Cascades and parts of far northern Rockies

### **Tomorrow November 3:**

- Rain and thunderstorms from Mid-Atlantic to southern Appalachians
- Rain and snow from upstate New York to northern Maine; rain portions of northern New England coastal region
- Rain for the eastern sections of the Carolinas; rain/thunderstorms from Southeast coast south along Florida east coast

- More rain for Mississippi Delta and far southern Mississippi region
- Showers and thunderstorms across southern Four Corners and most of Texas; heavy rain, flash flooding across southeast New Mexico into a small part of Texas
- Rain and snow higher elevations of southern Utah and Colorado
- Rain continues across western Washington; Rain/snow for Washington Cascades and far northern Rockies
