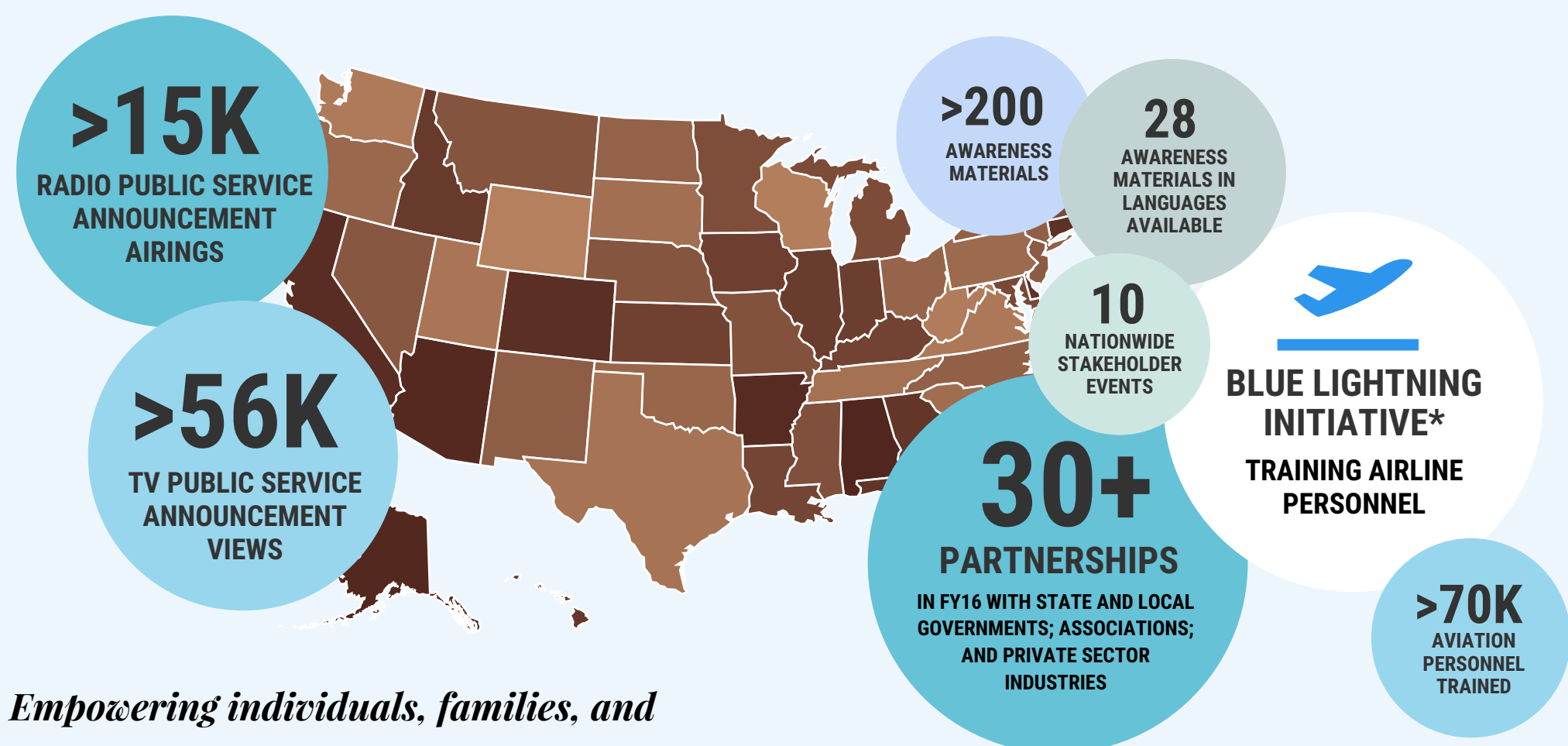
# DHS EFFORTS TO COMBAT HUMAN TRAFFICKING

## Raising National Awareness



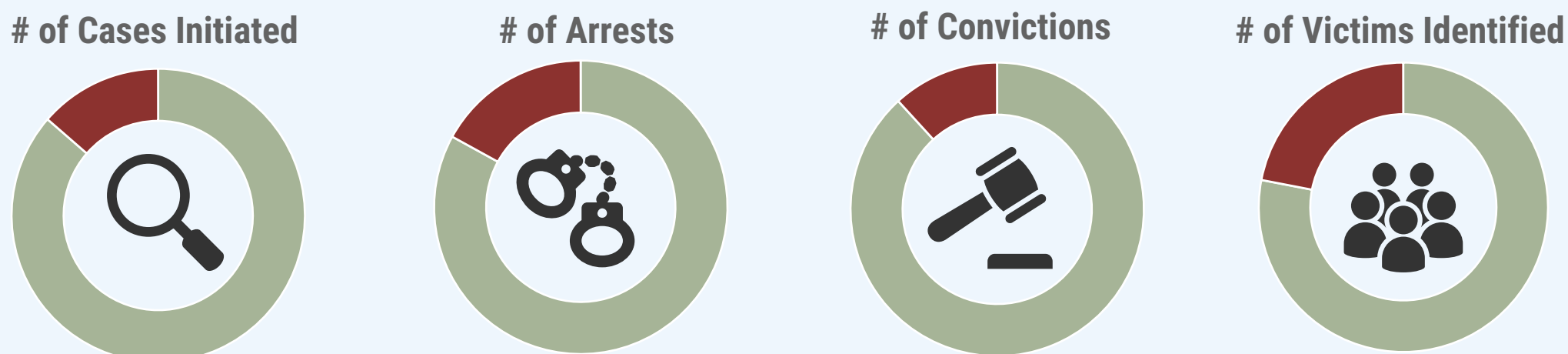
*Empowering individuals, families, and communities to recognize and report human trafficking.*

## Bringing Criminals to Justice



HSI initiated **6,507** cases of human trafficking between FY11 and FY16. **1,025** were initiated in FY16.

HSI made **9,481** arrests between FY11 and FY16. **1,943** were made in FY16.

HSI criminal arrests led to **4,392** convictions between FY11 and FY16. **587** were made in FY16.

HSI identified **2,084** victims between FY11 and FY16. **435** were identified in FY16.

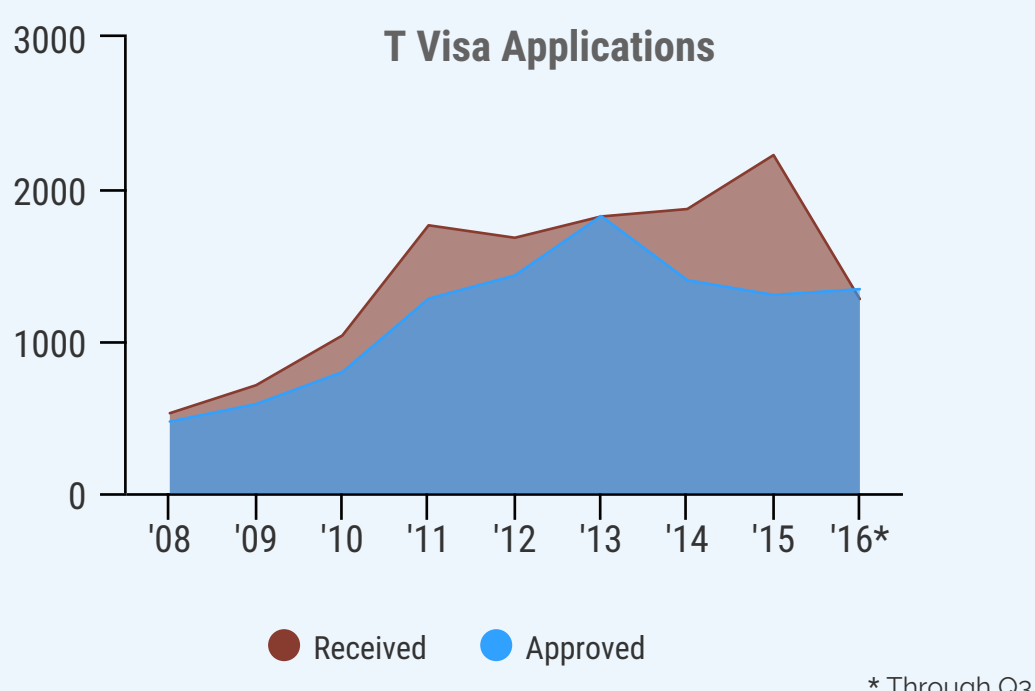
