SUBJECT: April 2013 Civil Reserve Air Fleet (CRAF) Allocation

The January 2013 CRAF allocation issued January 28, 2013 is hereby amended. The distribution reflected in this letter, effective April 1, 2013, brings the CRAF allocations up-to-date. Total allocations by segment are listed in Enclosure 1. Enclosure 2 lists the current aircraft allocated to the CRAF Program by carrier and tail number.

The Alaska section consists of 4 cargo aircraft. The Domestic section consists of 36 aircraft. The Aeromedical Evacuation segment consists of 0 aircraft. The Short-Range International section consists of 4 cargo and 122 passenger aircraft. The Long-Range International section consists of 154 cargo and 234 passenger aircraft. Total aircraft in the CRAF program is 554.
