SUBJECT: July 2013 Civil Reserve Air Fleet (CRAF) Allocation

The April 2013 CRAF allocation issued May 9, 2013 is hereby amended. The distribution reflected in this letter, effective July 1, 2013, brings the CRAF allocations up-to-date. Total allocations by segment are listed in Enclosure 1. Enclosure 2 lists the current aircraft allocated to the CRAF Program by carrier and tail number.

The Alaska section consists of 4 cargo aircraft. The Domestic section consists of 36 aircraft. The Aeromedical Evacuation segment consists of 0 aircraft. The Short-Range International section consists of 4 cargo and 122 passenger aircraft. The Long-Range International section consists of 153 cargo and 234 passenger aircraft. Total aircraft in the CRAF program is 553.

The above allocations are authorized in conformance with the Defense Production Act of 1950 (DPA), as amended (50 U.S.C., App. 2061, et seq.)
