The Alaska section consists of four cargo aircraft. The Domestic section consists of 36 aircraft. The Aeromedical Evacuation segment consists of 39 aircraft. The Short-Range International section consists of 4 cargo and 320 passenger aircraft. The Long-Range International section consists of 234 cargo and 526 passenger aircraft. Total aircraft in the CRAF program is 1,164.
