




MISSION STATEMENT

The Bureau is responsible for the maintenance and repair of 790 City owned vehicular and pedestrian bridges throughout the 5 boroughs.















BRIDGE & TUNNEL OPERATIONS Collage of bridge types

- 25 Movable Bridges
 - Bascule (12), Swing (7), Vertical Lift (4), Retractile (2)
 - 6,500 openings / year
 - On demand openings 24 / 7
 - Mobile Crew Operations
- Electrical Tunnel Maintenance & Repair
 - Pump and Ventilation Maintenance













