<u>Background:</u> The initial challenge of the Every Day Counts (EDC) initiative was to accelerate the deployment of ten (10) proven but not widely implemented innovative strategies and five (5)

technologies that are aimed at shortening project delivery and enhancing project performance. EDC is about pursuing better, faster, and smarter ways of doing business. Beyond the deployment of the initial 10 strategies and 5 technologies, the STILT will serve as forum for considering the rapid deployment of other innovative strategies and technologies in the future.

<u>Team Member Responsibilities:</u> Provide input on the initiatives to be pursued, determine applicability to Illinois, appoint agency and industry representatives to the deployment teams, and establish performance goals to measure success. Select activities to be funded under the State Transportation Innovative Council Incentive Program. Render STILT decisions by the consensus of all participating members subject to the concurrence of the IDOT and FHWA coteam leaders.

<u>Approach:</u> The STILT will meet on a quarterly basis prior to the regularly scheduled IDOT/AGC Policy meetings in Springfield, Illinois

Time Frames:

The STILT will be an on-going team and will only be disbanded upon agreement of the two coteam leaders.
