



- Contracts with Energy Service Companies (ESCOs)
- Guaranteed savings, verified through annual Measurement and Verification (M&V) reports

Capital Improvements – Design & Engineering Procurements



- Current Architect-Engineer IDIQ Contracts:
 - PWD Rota Spain AE IDIQ (Rota, Moron, etc.)
 - Base year of 3 year contract (Base Year + 2 option years)
 - PWD Souda Bay AE IDIQ
 - Base year of 3 year contract (Base Year + 2 option years)
 - Europe AE IDIQ
 - Base Year of 5 year contract (Base year + 4 option years)
 - Africa/Southwest Asia AE IDIQ
 - Currently in 1st option year (Base Year + 2 Option Years)
- Way Ahead
 - No longer procuring AE MAC
 - HQ ACQ policy
 - Diversified ACQ Toolbox
 - Must review requirements across the AOR
 - Match tools (IDIQ) to requirements,
 - Specialty Contracts, i.e. Mech/Elec, Civ/Struct, Waterfront, etc.
 - Similar approach will be applied to Construction MACCs

Capital Improvements Construction Procurements



• Construction

- Multiple Award Construction Contracts (MACC)
 - Design-Build MACC Contract Capability
 - 3 to 5 Construction Contractors
 - Typically 5 year MACC contracts (Base year + 4 option years)

Design / Acquisition Planning



Strategic Program Guidelines

- Design Strategy
 - Determine in-house capacity for RFP/design development
 - Reach back to available LANT and MIDLANT AE vehicles to distribute surge work

- Construction Acquisition Strategy - general guidelines

- >\$10M Stand Alone Full and Open
- <\$10M Consideration for MACC applicability</p>
- Planning becomes more tactical when the program is authorized

- Variation from Design-Build when upfront design required due to

- Project complexity/Specific Design control required
- Permitting requirements (Complex host nation / Mixed Commission agreements)
- Explosive Safety Approval (NOSSA / DDESB)
- Supported Commander preference
- Need for in-house design experience

- Variations in Acquisition Strategy include

- MACC capacity and scope applicability
- Use Stand Alone where MACCs do not offer specialization (Piers/Airfields)
- Project packaging due to proximity of projects
- Timing of multiple solicitations
- Contract Packaging in logistically challenging locations
 - Africa, Remote locations in Europe and Southwest Asia

Acquisition Methods & Vehicles



Full and Open Competition

- Low-Price/ Technically Acceptable (LPTA)
- Best Value Source Selection (BVSS) the Tradeoff Process
- May award with or without discussions

• Multiple Award Construction Contracts – 5 yr POP

- As many as 6 contractors selected
- Full and Open within MACC
- Current MACCs: Bahrain, CLDJ, Naples, Sigonella, Rota
- Presently Soliciting: CLDJ, Naples, Sigonella and Souda Bay

• Job Order Contract (JOC) – 5 yr POP

- Naples, Souda Bay, CLDJ, Bahrain, Rota

•Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity <u>A&E</u> Contracts – 3 yr POP

- Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity <u>Construction</u> Contracts
 - Paving/Paving (Rota in Solicitation), Roofing (Sigonella), Utility Distribution, CWU/CLU
