Your request for a second 180-day extension for your accreditation audit for the Florence Service Processing Center has been received. In light of your need to complete structural construction for your food service area, your request is approved. In the event that the facility is not able to successfully complete an audit and have a panel hearing by January 2009, Florence SPC's accreditation will expire. In the event that the accreditation expires, Florence SPC will be removed from the accreditation process. After a period of six months Florence SPC could re-apply for accreditation, and upon acceptance back into the accreditation program, would undergo an initial audit at such a time as agreed upon between the ACA and the Florence SPC.
