Mishap Reporting Program

Injuries:

- All injuries to MCB Quantico Marines, on or off duty, must be reported via the Enterprise Safety Application Management System (ESAMS), regardless of how minor
- All work related injuries to MCB Quantico employees must be reported via ESAMS, regardless of how minor
- Any work related loss of consciousness must be reported
- Any Marine or Civilian who is diagnosed by the Naval Health Clinic with a Permanent Threshold Shift (STS) in their hearing, must notify their supervisor, the supervisor must report the STS as a mishap
- Tenant activities aboard MCB Quantico will report all injuries meeting Navy/USMC/OSHA requirements via the Web Enabled Safety System (WESS)

Property Damage:

- Any incident involving damage to Marine Corps owned property must be reported as a mishap, this includes GOV accidents
- All Reported mishaps will be investigated and tracked by a qualified Safety Specialist
