

TRANSFER OF POST 9/11 GI BILL BENEFITS

MARADMIN 389/09, MARADMIN 421/09, and MARADMIN 457/09 discuss the Post 9/11 GI Bill transferability process. There are 3 steps that all Marines requesting to transfer benefits must complete in order for the transfer to take place.

STEPS TO COMPLETING TRANSFER OF POST 9/11 GI BILL BENEFITS:

1. Request transfer of benefits online via http://www.defense.gov/home/features/2009/0409_gibill/
2. Complete the Post 9/11 Educational Benefits Transferability Commitment and Statement of Understanding available at https://www.manpower.usmc.mil/portal/page/portal/M_RA_HOME
3. Submit signed SOU to the Customer Service Branch, Audits Section for approval.

Before submitting the hard copy statement of understanding to the Customer Service Branch, ensure that all required additional obligated service is annotated in MCTFS. The statement of understanding explains the obligated service requirements. Enlisted personnel should see their unit career retention specialists in order to obtain the required service via reenlistment or extension of enlistment.

In order for the benefits to be successfully transferred to your family member, all three of these steps must be completed.
