AIR FORCE ACADEMY CADETS

Each year the Air Force Academy identifies a percentage of the senior class to enter the Medical Health Profession. These cadets are guaranteed a scholarship if they are accepted into an accredited medical school within the continental US or Puerto Rico or USUHS prior to their graduation date. Cadets not accepted into a medical school by graduating date will be commissioned into the line of the Air Force.

HQ AFPC/DP2NP (Physician Education) is notified by cadet affairs the recipients of the prehealth scholarship. In turn, DP2NP provides the contract packages to cadet affairs for distribution to the scholarship recipients.

Academy cadets not identified to participate in the program are ineligible to apply for AFHPSP or USUHS. There are no waivers for this as the number of cadets who can enter the program is limited by public law. Academy cadets are considered contractually obligated as line of the Air Force assets.

Cadets should contact HQ USAFA/DPYC, as soon as they receive an unconditional acceptance to an accredited medical school within the continental US or Puerto Rico or USUHS. DPYC will provide cadets with a contract and pay package. Once cadets complete the contract/pay package, they will return it to DPYC to be sent to DP2NP.
