## **USMLE/COMLEX Scores & Medical Licensure**

All applicants are required to upload into MODS a copy of the <u>official transcript</u> from the NBME or NBOME showing <u>all</u> current exam dates and scores. Individual score reports are not acceptable.

MEDICAL STUDENTS: Selection for Graduate Medical Education (GME) is a competitive process that occurs through the Joint Service Graduate Medical Education Selection Board (JSGMESB). It is strongly recommended that you complete both the written and practical components of the Step/Level 2 licensing exams prior to the board. You must upload into MODS the complete NBME or NBOME transcript with Step/Level 1 and 2 scores no later than 15 October, showing all exam dates and scores including unsuccessful attempts. Keep in mind that it may take up to 6 weeks to receive your results after you test. Alternately, students may have a medical school official complete score report letter with a verification of all test attempts. A template is provided below in the Useful Documents section.

**NOTE:** Selection for GME is contingent upon successful completion of Steps/Levels 1 and 2 and graduation from medical school prior to the start of GME (1 July 2017). If you are unable to successfully complete these requirements by 1 July 2017, your case will be evaluated for action by Physician Education (i.e., academic leave of absence, separation with recoupment of scholarship, etc.).

<u>CURRENT INTERNS:</u> You must have <u>scheduled</u> Step/Level 3 no later than the application deadline of <u>15 October</u>. The test date must be submitted with your application on the **Step/Level 3 Intention Form** available in the USEFUL DOCUMENTS section of this site.

Step/Level 3 must be <u>taken</u> prior to **15 March 2017**, with passing results received by Physician Education no later than **30 April 2017**. Selection for GME is contingent on successful completion of the Step/Level 3 licensing exam. There are <u>no exceptions</u> to this requirement.

<u>CURRENT RESIDENTS & STAFF PHYSICIANS:</u> You are required to upload into MODS a copy of the official transcript from the NBME or NBOME showing all current exam dates and scores, including Step/Level 3. Individual score reports are not acceptable.

If you are a PGY2 or later, you must have a current, unrestricted state medical license uploaded into MODS no later than the application deadline of 15 October in accordance with AFI 44-119, paragraph 4.4.1.1. Please do not upload into MODS a copy of the licensing certificate unless the expiration date is listed. Internet verifications or a copy of a wallet card are preferred.

For second residency or fellowship training applicants, <u>board certification is required</u>. If Board Certification is pending, this must be addressed in the Personal Essay. This does not apply to residents currently in training.
