

Medical School Performance Evaluation (or Dean's Letter)

The official Medical Student Performance Evaluation (MSPE) must be uploaded into MODS by the applicant or medical school. Applicants must ensure that an MSPE is uploaded into MODS for inclusion in the application. This document is extremely important to the Joint Services Graduate Medical Education Selection Board (JSGMESB) application. If you have previously applied to the JSGMESB through MODS, your MSPE should not need to be uploaded again. Members are encouraged to maintain a copy for their personal files.

Note: If a U.S./foreign medical school graduate is unable to obtain a MSPE due to extenuating circumstances, the applicant must write a brief, signed memorandum explaining the circumstances. This memorandum should be uploaded into MODS in place of the MSPE. Please understand your MSPE is used for scoring purposes and the absence of this document in your application could adversely affect your score.
