OFFSEASON ACTIVITY INFORMATION: When the Game Checking Station is CLOSED

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE:

- ♦ Scouting, trapping, and firewood cutting is allowed 0730-1600, Sunday Saturday
- ♦ The sign-in sheet is located in the weigh shed (small shed across the street from the Game Checking Station)
- ♦ Each person must include date, pass number, name, MCBQ license number, training area, cell phone, home phone, vehicle make/model/color, license plate number, and time in and out
- ♦ There will be a clipboard with the training area activity schedule posted in the weigh shed. Be sure to confirm that the training area you intend to check into that day is **OPEN**
- ♦ All people scouting and trapping must carry a <u>walking pass</u>. Keep this pass with you at all times while in the field and return the pass when checking out
- ♦ Everyone must check out at the weigh shed by 1600 (4pm)

LICENSE SALES:

- ◆ The Game Checking Station will be open for MCBQ license sales during hunting seasons (see annual hunt bulletin)
- ♦ Firewood permits can be obtained at the Marine Corps Exchange REC/ITT Desk while the Game Checking Station is closed
- ♦ All base fishing licenses can be purchased as the Marine Corps Exchange at the sporting goods counter

GAME CHECK STATION OPERATION HOURS:

- ♦ The Game Checking Station will be open Monday Saturday thru January 24, 2015
- ♦ The Game Checking Station will be closed from January 25, 2015 April 2, 2015
- ♦ The Game Checking Station will reopen April 3, 4, 10, and April 11- May 16, 2015
- ♦ All scouting will end at the end of Spring Gobbler Season, May 16, 2015
