#### **Department Services:**

Gynecology: Active duty, dependent and civilian women with minor to major gynecological problems are eligible. Age range encompasses any eligible female on Misawa AB.

Appointments include: routine GYN (to include birth control, hormone therapy, etc.), infertility on a space-available basis, cancer screening (Pap smear, colposcopy, and breast evaluation).

Procedures: LEEP, colposcopy, lower genital tract biopsies, intrauterine device insertion and removal, Norplant removal, Implanon removal, Nexplanon insertion and removal, bladder cystometric testing, endometrial sampling and ultrasound.

Obstetric: Active duty, dependent, and civilian women including both normal and high risk pregnancies. Age range encompasses any eligible female on Misawa AB.

Appointments include: antepartum and postpartum.

Procedures: amniocentesis and ultrasound.

## Walk-In Services:

Pregnancy - Monday-Friday 7:30a.m. - 8:30a.m & 1:00pm -2:00pm Must be 5 days late for their cycle and must have already taken 2 POSITIVE home pregnancy test prior to coming

Injection - Monday-Friday 7:30a.m.-8:00a.m.

For DEPO patients, they must be in their window and must have prescription picked up prior to clinic check-in

#### **Patient Instructions:**

The Obstetrics and Gynecology Clinic is a referral only clinic with the exception of the Obstetric Care.
