## **U.S. Air Force Fact Sheet** 927 AEROSPACE MEDICINE SQUADRON (AFRC)

Lineage. Constituted as 927 Tactical Hospital, and activated, on 15 Jan 1963. Organized in the Reserve on 11 Feb 1963. Redesignated as: 927 Tactical Dispensary on 25 Jun 1969; 927 Tactical Hospital on 29 Jun 1971. Inactivated on 1 Mar 1977. Activated in the Reserve on 1 Nov 1983. Redesignated as: 927 Medical Squadron on 1 Nov 1990; 927 Aerospace Medicine Squadron on 1 Jul 2000; 927 Aerospace Medicine Flight on 1 Sep 2003; 927 Aerospace Medicine Squadron on 1 Mar 2011.

Assignments. 927 Troop Carrier (later, 927 Tactical Airlift; 927 Tactical Air Support; 927 Tactical Airlift) Group, 11 Feb 1963; 403 Aerospace Rescue and Recovery (later, 403 Rescue and Weather Reconnaissance) Wing, 15 Mar 1976-1 Mar 1977. 927 Tactical Airlift (later, 927 Airlift; 927 Air Refueling) Group, 1 Nov 1983; 927 Medical Group, 1 Oct 1994; 927 Air Refueling Wing, 1 Apr 1997-.

Stations. Selfridge AFB, MI, 11 Feb 1963-1 Mar 1977. Selfridge AGB (later, ANGB), MI, 1 Nov 1983; MacDill AFB, FL, 1 May 2008-.
