DISASTER WARNING^{1,3}	IF YOU HEAR 3-5 MINUTE STEADY TONE ON SIREN OR SIMILAR WARNING DEVICE 	THIS INDICATES A DISASTER SITUATION AFFECTING THE BASE IS IMMINENT OR IN PROGRESS EXAMPLES: TOXIN DIVERS, FLOODING, HAZARDOUS MATERIAL RELEASES, WILDFIRES

SEE AF1 10-2501, AIR FORCE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM, PLANNING AND OPERATIONS AND AFMAN 10-2504, AIR FORCE INCIDENT RESPONSE AND MAJOR ACCIDENTS AND DISASTERS FOR FURTHER GUIDANCE ON USING SIRENS AND PROTECTIVE ACTION AREAS. THE SIREN AND PROTECTIVE ACTION AREAS WILL BE USED TO INITIATE PASSIVE DEFENSE ACTIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH AFMAN 10-2503, OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF RADIOLOGICAL, NUCLEAR, AND HIGH-WELD EXPLOSION RESPONSE PROGRAMS AS DIRECTED BY THE INSTALLATION COMMANDER.
 2. THE SIREN AND PROTECTIVE ACTION AREAS WILL BE USED TO INITIATE PASSIVE DEFENSE ACTIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH AFMAN 10-2503, OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF RADIOLOGICAL, NUCLEAR, AND HIGH-WELD EXPLOSION RESPONSE PROGRAMS AS DIRECTED BY THE INSTALLATION COMMANDER.
 3. SENIOR BARRING PERSONNEL COMPLETES PERSONNEL ACCOUNTABILITY AND REPORTS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE USING LOCAL PROCEDURES.
 4. SENIOR BARRING PERSONNEL COMPLETES PERSONNEL ACCOUNTABILITY AND REPORTS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE USING LOCAL PROCEDURES.

What is it?


Whether it's a natural disaster, security or wartime event, the Holloman AFB Mass Notification System's goal is to provide timely and effective alert notifications to base personnel. This is accomplished via two methods:

- 1) AtHoc
 - Desktop pop-ups
 - E-mail
 - Voice phone calls
 - Text messages
- 2) Giant Voice
 - Voice message
 - Loud tone



What do I need to do?

Ensure information in AtHoc is correct!

1. Right-click on the purple globe in the bottom right side of your desktop 
2. Select "Access Self-Service" option
3. Click on "My Profile"
4. Click on "Edit" button
5. Verify "Basic Info", "Numbers", "Online addresses" & "Base Specific Info" sections then "Save"
6. **Update Org Info by clicking on "/" then follow the org tree to your unit**
7. Highly encouraged to add cell phone number for text messaging for timely notifications

Follow directions from AtHoc and/or Giant Voice notifications
