Flight 1209/29OCT PBI-DFW scheduled for departure at 0915/EST incurred a 4.45 hr. delay for mechanical reasons. The aircraft's forward cargo door was opened and all the live animal cages on board were moved near the open door. Door remained open for the duration of the delay. Water was offered to all the animals on board at approximately 1130/EST. At 1401/EST the aircraft left the gate and arrived in DFW at 1559/CST. Buster was found dead on arrival in DFW.

Narrative Description of Cause of the Incident

Buster was sent for autopsy. The report states ".....death of this animal was due to age related and environmental stress factors". A subsequent histopathology report states Buster's diagnosis as "acute to subecute diffuse pulmonary congestion with etelectasis".

Narrative Description of any Corrective Action Taken in Response to Incident

None, as the autopsy/histopathology report suggests death was due to age related causes and illness.

Narrative description of any corrective action to be taken in response to the incident: Necropsy report and subsequent consultation indicates puppy died due to Alveolar Histolytic Inflammation (Respitory distress) that was pre-existing about 72 hours prior to shipment compounded by Dystrophic Mineralization (large amounts of minerals) causing hardening of the tissues possibly due to over-supplementation.
