Thank you for your memorandum dated August 24, 2009, to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), conveying the National Advisory Council's (NAC) recommendations for potential statutory changes to the Stafford Act. As always, we value your input, and appreciate the time and effort expended by the Committee to compile these thoughtful recommendations.

As you know, FEMA is undertaking a comprehensive review of its policies, regulations, and statutory authorities. These recommendations will be considered in that review, along with the recommendations submitted by the NAC on August 19, 2008, regarding specific Public Assistance and Individual Assistance regulatory reform issues and the recommendations submitted by the NAC on December 18, 2008, regarding specific Public Assistance and Individual Assistance policy reform issues.
