Colonel Christopher J. Beveridge is the commander of Eastern Sector, United States Military Entrance Processing Command.

Colonel Beveridge enlisted in the Utah Army National Guard in 1984 through the Salt Lake City MEPS. He served as a helicopter crew chief, 19th Special Forces Group (Airborne), Camp W.G. Williams, Utah. He later enrolled in the Army Reserve Officer Training Corps at Utah State University, Logan, graduating as a Distinguished Military Graduate and received his commission in 1989.

He served as platoon leader, 4th Personnel Services Company, 4th Infantry Division, Fort Carson, Colorado; officer strength manager, 4th Infantry Division; personnel officer, commander and battalion operations officer, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 4th Personnel Services Battalion; commander, A Detachment, 4th Personnel Services Battalion; deployed as joint personnel officer to Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, Joint Task Force 160; battalion personnel officer, Portland, Oregon, Recruiting Battalion; battalion personnel officer and battalion executive officer, Salt Lake City Recruiting Battalion, Utah; personnel operations officer, executive officer to the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel, and executive officer to the Chief of Staff, Headquarters, United States Army in Europe, Heidelberg, Germany; assistant executive officer, Director of the Army Staff, Office of the Chief of Staff, United States Army, Pentagon, Arlington, Virginia; deployed as a senior military advisor to the Director of Manpower, Iraqi Ministry of Defense, Multi-National Transition Command-Iraq; commander, 12th Battalion and Baltimore MEPS, Maryland; chief, Military Secretariat, Director for Strategic Plans and Policy, Joint Staff.
