## First Sergeant Roxana M. Campbell

First Sergeant Roxana M. Campbell is the senior enlisted advisor of the Lansing Military Entrance Processing Station.

First Sergeant Campbell enlisted in the U.S. Army in December 1992. She completed Basic Combat Training and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Jackson, S.C., as a human resources specialist. Upon her first assignment was to Fort Campbell, Ky., where she served with Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault), as a personnel actions specialist. She was next assigned to Fort Hood, Texas, where she served with 1st Brigade, 4th Infantry Division, as the assistant noncommissioned officer in charge of human resources, and later, as the executive administrative assistant to the 4th Infantry Division Commander. During this period she deployed twice in Support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. In 2009, she was reassigned to the Warrior Transition Brigade, also at Fort Hood, where she served as a platoon sergeant. Her next assignment was to Fort Jackson, S.C., where she served with 2nd Battalion, 13th Infantry Regiment, as a drill sergeant. She was then assigned to Fort Drum, N.Y., where she served with 10th Mountain Division, as the executive administrative assistant for operations. During this tour of duty she was inducted into the Audie Murphy Club. Her next assignment was to Schofield Barracks, Hawaii, where she served with Headquarters and Headquarters Company, Division Support Command, 25th Infantry Division (Light), as an awards and evaluations clerk, and later, as an administrative specialist for the 25th Infantry Division Inspector General Office. Prior to her current assignment, she was stationed at Fort Hood, where she served with 48th Chemical Brigade, as the noncommissioned officer in charge of human resources.



Her professional military education includes the Warrior, Advanced and Senior Leader Courses, Drill Sergeant School, Warrior Transition Unit Triad Course, Equal Opportunity Leaders Course, and Air Assault School.

Her military awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, four Meritorious Service Medals, six Army Commendation Medals, seven Army Achievement Medals and various unit and service medals and ribbons.
