Master Chief Petty Officer Chad Elliott is the senior enlisted advisor of the Milwaukee Military Entrance Processing Station.

He enlisted in the Navy in September 1993 and attended basic training at the Naval Training Center, San Diego. His assignments include hazard material control supervisor aboard the Spruance-class destroyer USS Fletcher, homeported in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii; department financial storekeeper, Naval Security Group Activity, Kunia, Hawaii; supply petty officer, Navy Operational Support Center, Des Moines, Iowa; material control leading petty officer, Strike Fighter Squadron 201, Fort Worth, Texas; wing material control leading petty officer, Commander Fleet Logistics Support Wing, Fort Worth; wing material leading chief, Tactical Support Wing, Fort Worth; supply department leading chief aboard the Oliver Hazard Perry-class guided missile frigate USS Curts, homeported in San Diego, and deployed to the South Pacific; and logistics department leading chief and senior enlisted advisor, Commander Naval Logistics Group, 1st Navy Expeditionary Logistics Regiment, Williamsburg, Virginia.
