Major Walter J. Frazier is the commander of the Jackson Military Entrance Processing Station.

Major Frazier began his career in the Army in February 1992, enlisting through the Montgomery Military Entrance Processing Station, Alabama. Following his commission, he served as an assistant squadron fire support officer, Headquarters and Headquarters Troop, 2nd Squadron, 2nd Armored Cavalry Regiment, fire direction officer, Howitzer Battery, 2nd Armored Cavalry Regiment, rear detachment commander and battalion human resources officer, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 5th Battalion, 25th Field Artillery Regiment, 4th Brigade, 10th Mountain Division, all at Fort Polk, Louisiana; assistant and brigade human resources officer, 4th Brigade, 10th Mountain Division; battalion human resources officer, 2nd Battalion, 30th Infantry, 4th Brigade, 10th Mountain Division, commander, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, United States Army NATO Brigade, Tompkins Barracks, Germany; current operations officer, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, and secretary general staff officer in charge, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, United States Army NATO Brigade, Sembach, Germany.
